DAY 1

DAY 4

Middle Rhine Valley & a palace dinner

Today, enjoy a day of cruising the Middle Rhine Valley, designated a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Glide past fairy tale castles – there are 40 hilltop castles and fortresses here, erected over a period of 1,000 years – historic towns and sloping vineyards, hearing the stories of the Lorelei, the beautiful siren of the rocks. 

in the footsteps of Mark Twain, Goethe and the painter William Turner who was inspired by the landscapes you'll see today. Have lunch at a local restaurant, with time at leisure to experience this riverside city as you wish. Cocktails and dinner are served back aboard your riverboat, followed by evening entertainment as your cruise continues to Strasbourg, France this evening. **Meals BLD**

DAY 6

Explore the Alsatian wine route

This morning, your riverboat arrives in historic Strasbourg, France for a choice of excursions. Choose to explore here on a guided bicycle excursion that includes Old Town and the medieval alleys, half-timbered houses dressed in sherbet colors and a grand Gothic cathedral that dates back to1439. Alternatively, drive out to the Alsace wine region and tour the town of Colmar, followed by a lunch and tasting at a local countryside winery. **Meals BLD**

DAY 7

A choice of discoveries in Basel

Arrive in multicultural Basel, Switzerland, located at the juncture of the French, German and Swiss borders. Renowned as the Swiss Cultural Capital, Basel is home to some forty outstanding museums, including one of the oldest public art collections in the world. A choice of sightseeing includes a walking tour that inspires with insights about the city's art and architecture, including a self-guided visit to the world-class Basel Art Museum, boasting a history that dates back to 1661. Your other option today explores Basel's distinctive culinary heritage on a guided walking tour, indulging with tastings of local beer, Swiss cheese and chocolate. Enjoy free time to explore the sights on your own this afternoon. Join us this evening for a farewell toast and dinner onboard your riverboat. **Meals BLD**

DAY 8

By rail through the Alps & on to Milan

After breakfast, disembark for a scenic train ride to the stunning lakeside city of Lugano, for lunch and free time to explore. This afternoon, drive across the border into Italy for arrival in Milan, a city that reigns as a world capital of fashion and design. Tonight, you have reservations for a Tauck Exclusive experience, a private viewing of Milan's pièce de résistance, Leonardo da Vinci's mural, *The Last Supper*, which adorns the dining room at the Santa Maria delle Grazie convent (subject to availability; the day of this visit may vary). The Biebrich Palace in Wiesbaden-Biebrich, Germany is located directly on the banks of the Rhine with an extensive castle park. It was built in 1702 by Prince Georg August Samuel and served as a ducal residence for the independent Duchy of Nassau from 1816 to 1866. Tauck guests enjoy an exclusive private dinner with entertainment, and an opportunity to explore its magnificent three-wing baroque rooms.

DAY 9

Villas & villages of Lake Como

Drive to Tremezzina for a full day tour of the beautiful Lake Como region. Begin with a boat ride for bellissima Bellagio, taking in the mountainscape that surrounds you, followed by free time in this town known as the "Pearl of the Lake". Continue on your cruise en route to a private lunch at a restaurant on the shores of the lake. Return to Milan for a free evening to explore and dine as you please. **Meals BL**

DAY 10

Discover Milan

Experience Milan on a sightseeing drive and a locally guided walking tour that includes Piazza della Scala, Piazza Belgioioso, Piazza San Fedele, Palazzo Marina, and the Piazzo del Duomo, home to the Gothic Cathedral of Milan, il Duomo. The afternoon is free to explore on your own. You might want to take in La Scala, one of the most famous opera houses in the world, where Maria Callas sang her heart out; Pinacoteca di Brera, a great art collection including works by Raphael, Bellini, Piero della Francesca, and Caravaggio; the fashion district, via Montenapoleone, via Manzoni, and Corso Venezia. Be sure to taste the traditional flavors – sipping a Campari bitter apéritif and sampling dishes like yellow risotto and ossobuco. Join us for a farewell reception and dinner this evening at your hotel. **Meals BD**

DAY 11

Journey Home

Tour ends: Milan. Fly home anytime; a transfer from Hotel Principe di Savoia to Milan Malpensa or Linate Airports or Milan's Central Train Station is included. Allow three hours for flight check-in at the airport. **Meals B**

Tauck's 443-ft. (135-m.) riverboats – ms *Inspire*, ms *Savor*, ms *Joy* and ms *Grace* – are elegant reflections of the high standards that are consistent across Tauck's Destination Fleet, and carry on our tradition of providing more space per guest on Europe's rivers. With a maximum of 130 Tauck guests, these longer ships transport fewer passengers than most riverboats of comparable size in Europe. Of a 67 cabin total, we offer 22 Tauck Suites (300 square feet / 27.87 square meters) – the most of any riverboat on any European river. Guest amenities in these lush suites include separate seating areas, roomy walk-in closets and spacious bathrooms. All of our 443-ft. ships feature eight innovative loft cabins extending from the first to the second decks, affording more natural light and views of the passing scenery. Leisure facilities include a putting green and a whirlpool on the Sun Deck and a fitness center.


The Panorama Lounge, with its windows to the world, provides a great spot to meet and relax throughout the day.




The lobby is the central hub of the riverboat, highlighted by a grand staircase atrium.
